



Corn is done and soybeans are around 80% done. The corn and some soybeans are starting to emerge, but the soybeans need rain to germinate.


Rain is needed across the entire area. Alfalfa and small grains have slowed development because of the dry conditions.



Farmers in my area are wrapping up the last few soybean acres. We see a lot of emergence happening with corn poking up all over due to the heat last week.




#### 2021 Southwest Minnesota Departure From Normal




Farmers have 85-90% planted area-wide. The earliest planted soybeans and corn are starting to emerge.
