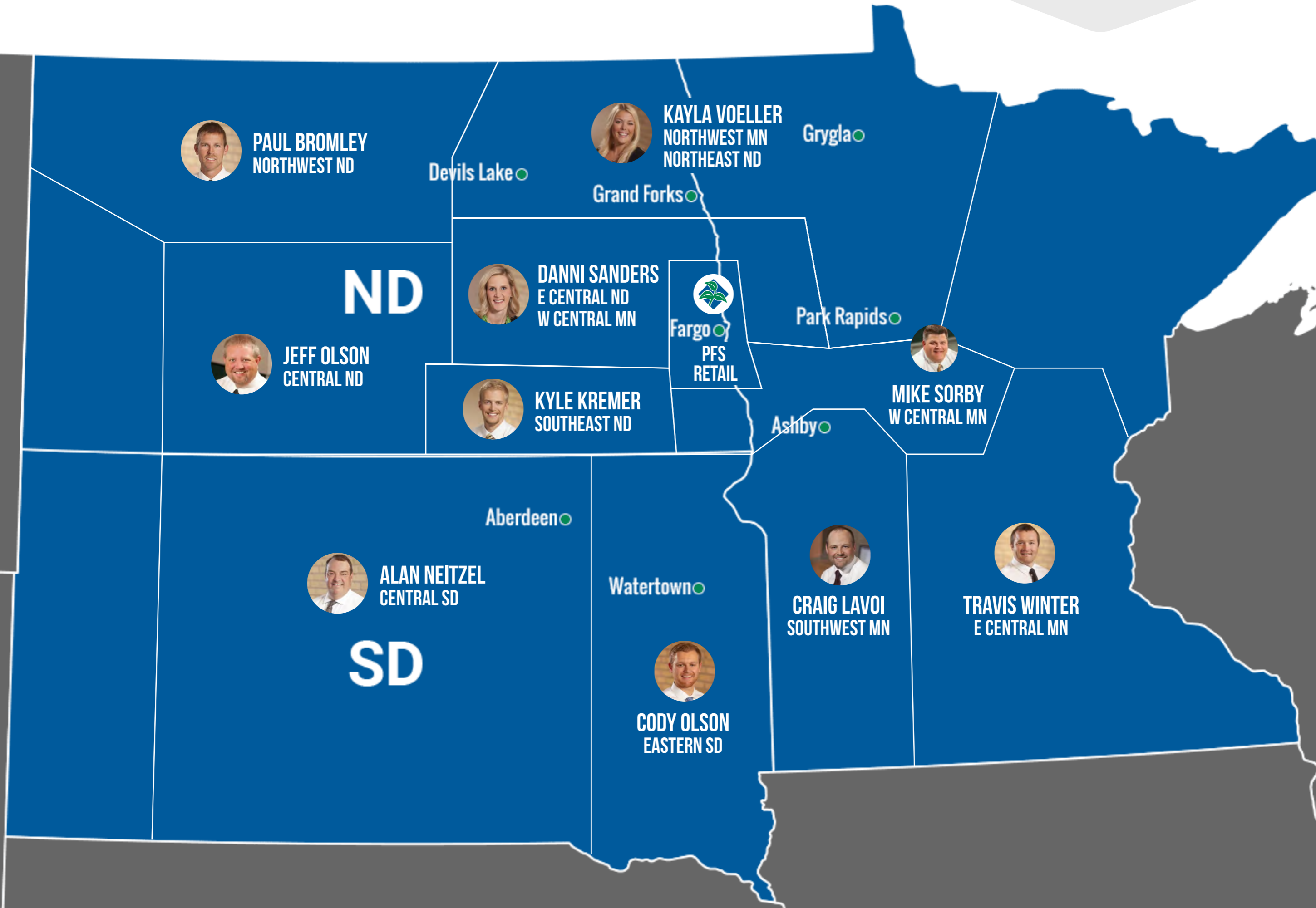

Farmers in my area are wrapping up the last few soybean acres. We see a lot of emergence happening with corn poking up all over due to the heat last week.

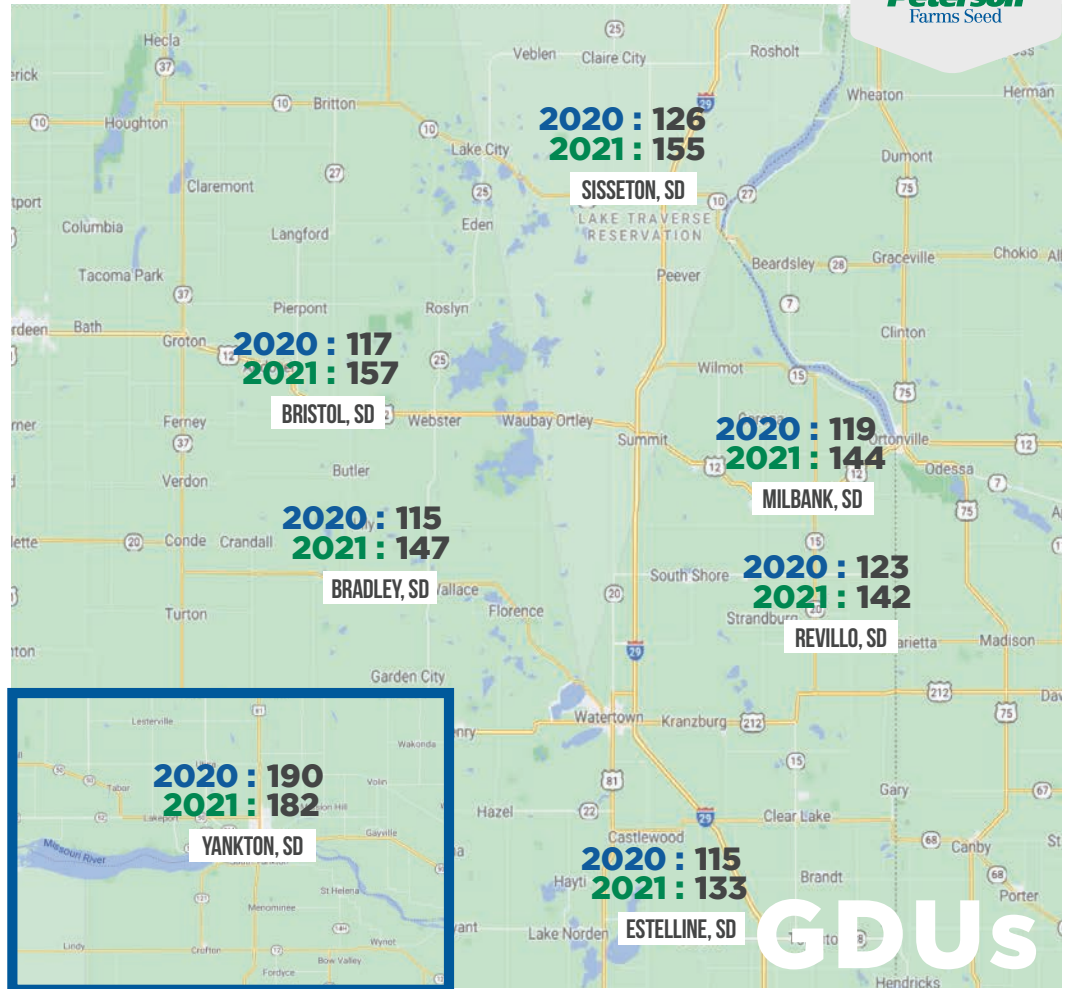
Everyone is looking forward to forecasted chances of rain in the next couple days.

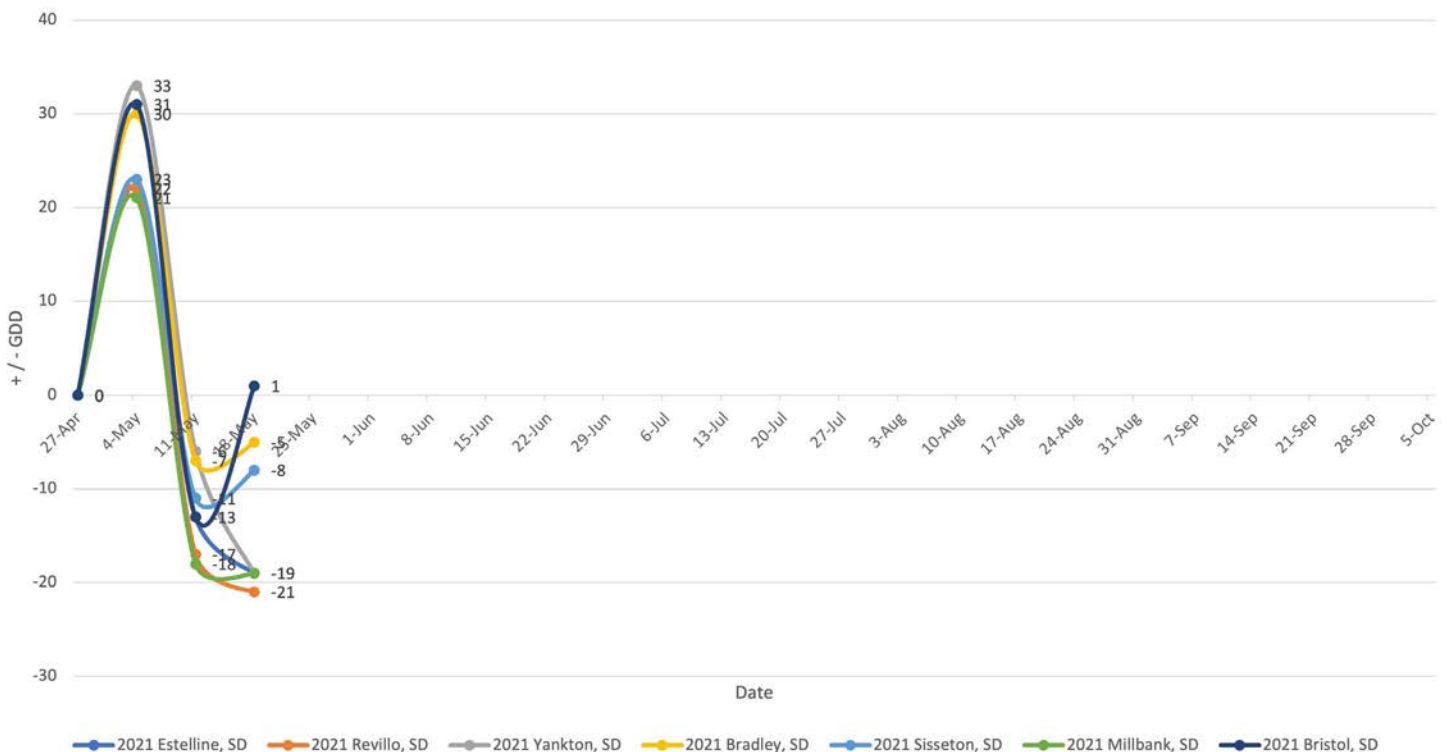

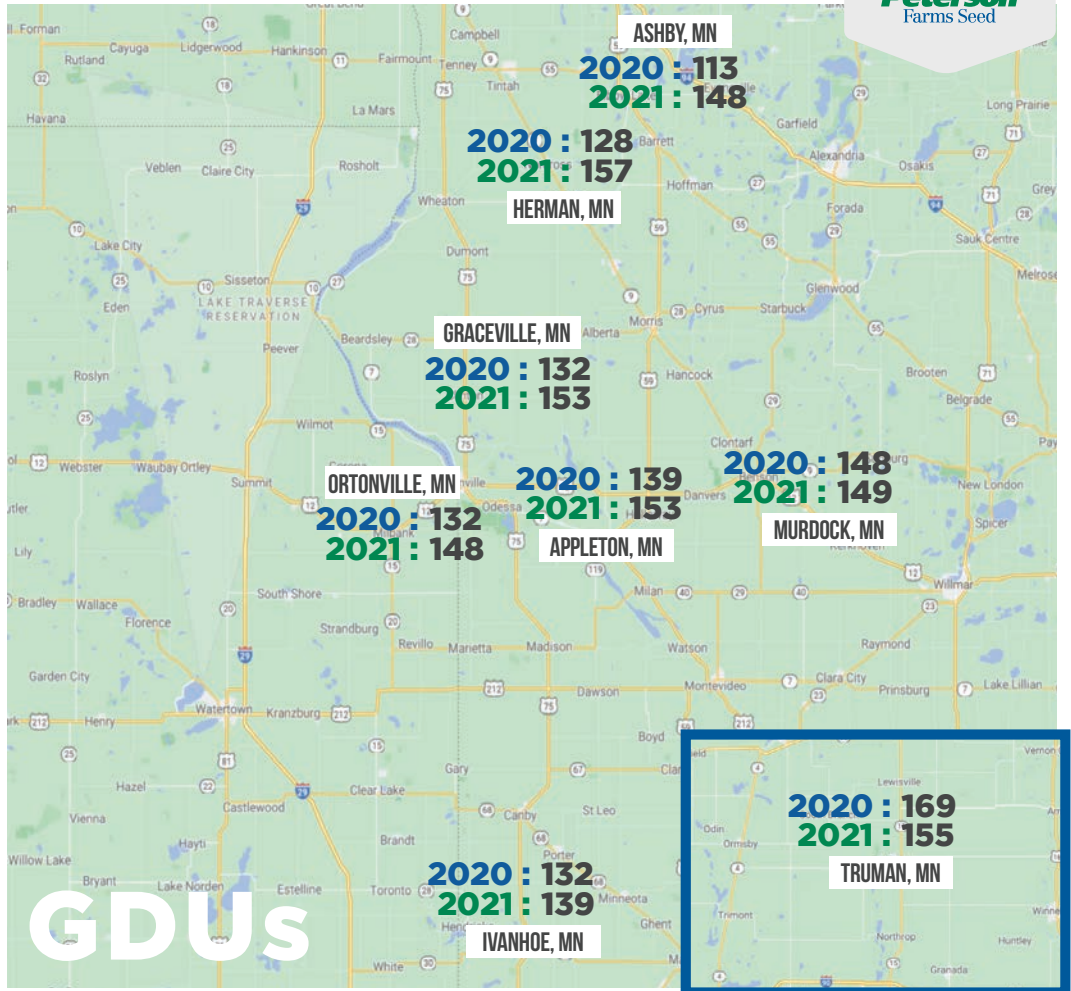
98% done with everything across all my area! Lots of crop poking through everywhere we look.

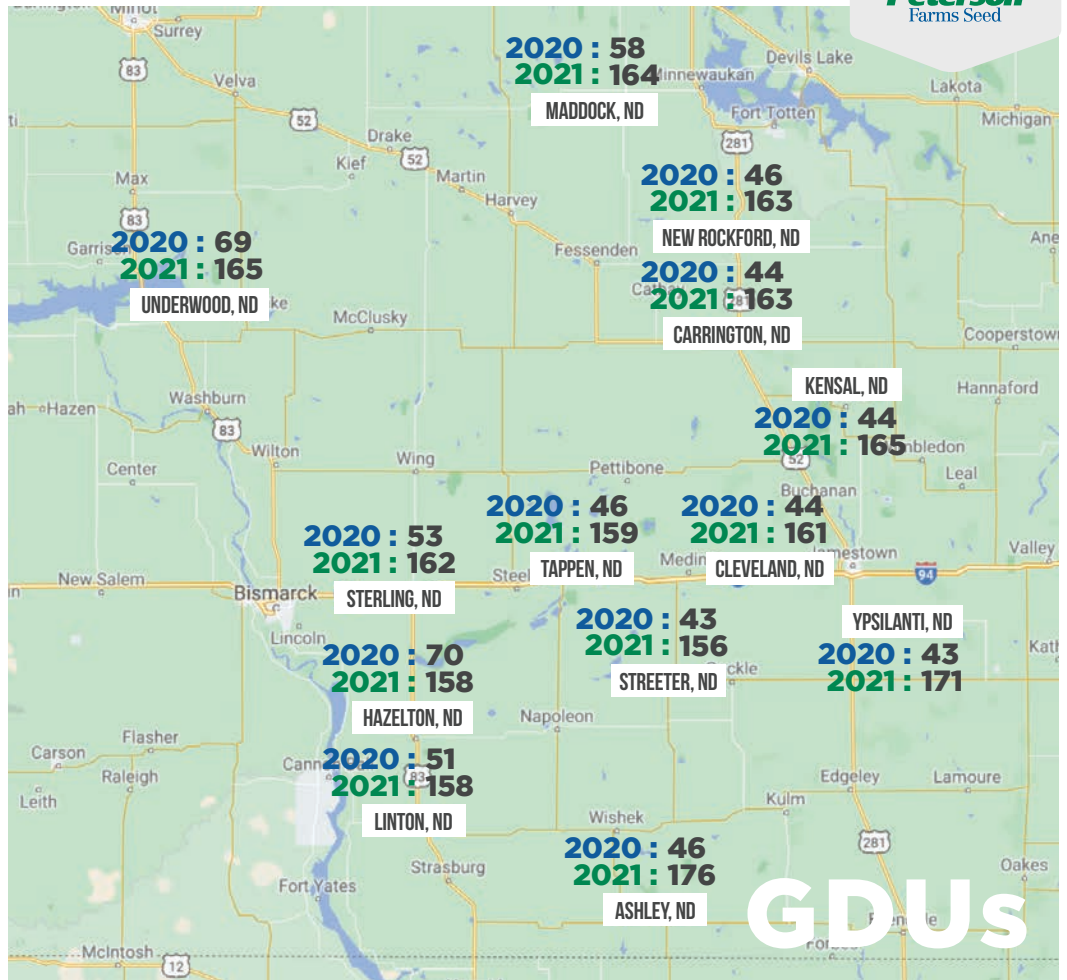
Farmers have 85-90% planted area-wide. The earliest planted soybeans and corn are starting to emerge.

We saw very spotty rain last week with only roughly 1/4 of my area's farmers seeing any moisture.



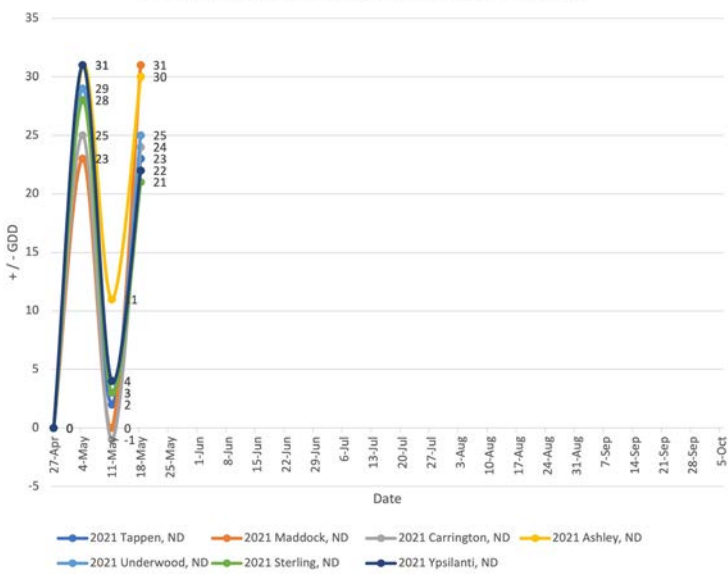

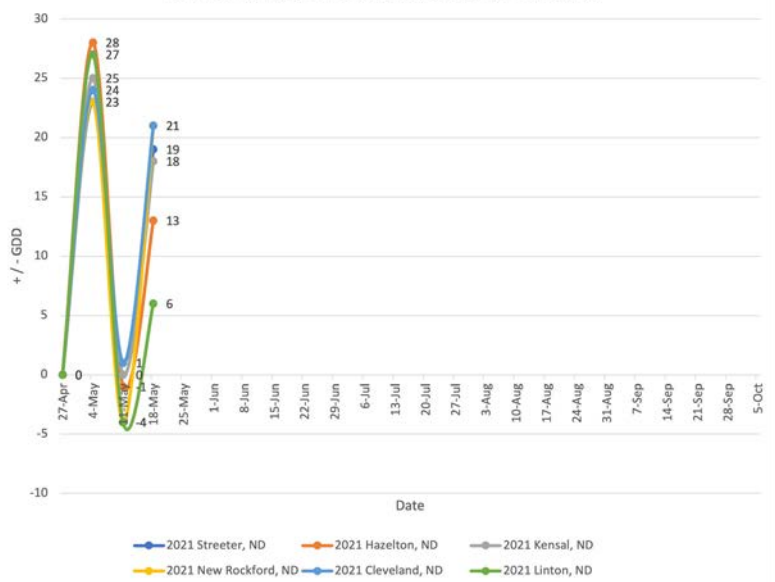

Farmers are almost finished planting for 2021!

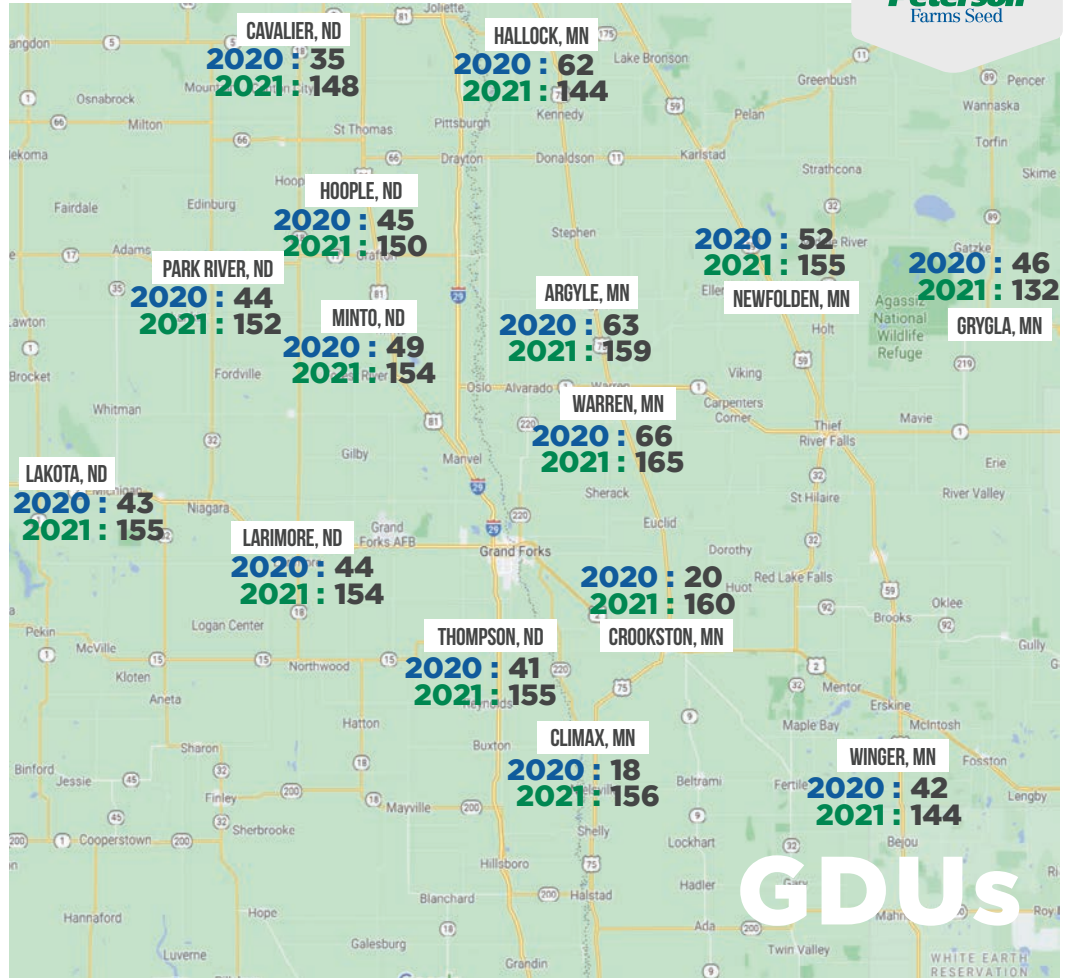
It's fun, especially in the far North, to watch how fast the corn is coming up!

The rain my area received late last week was spotty but extremely helpful.



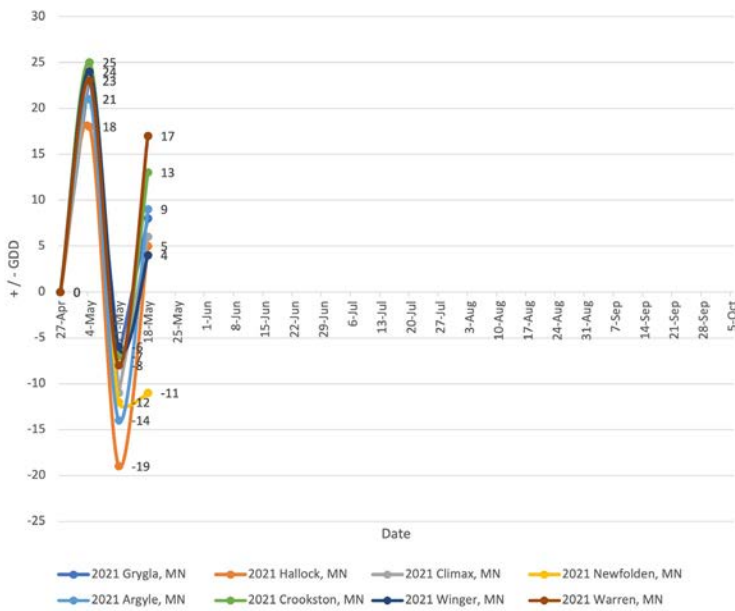

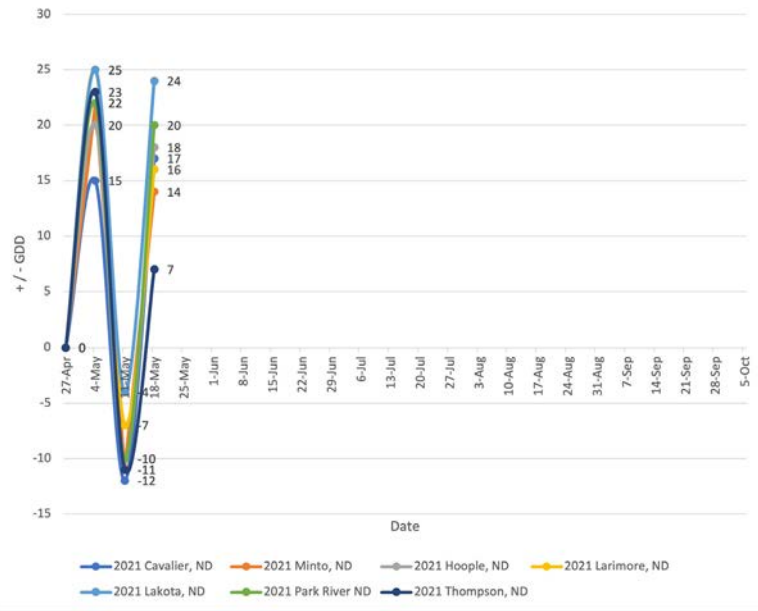

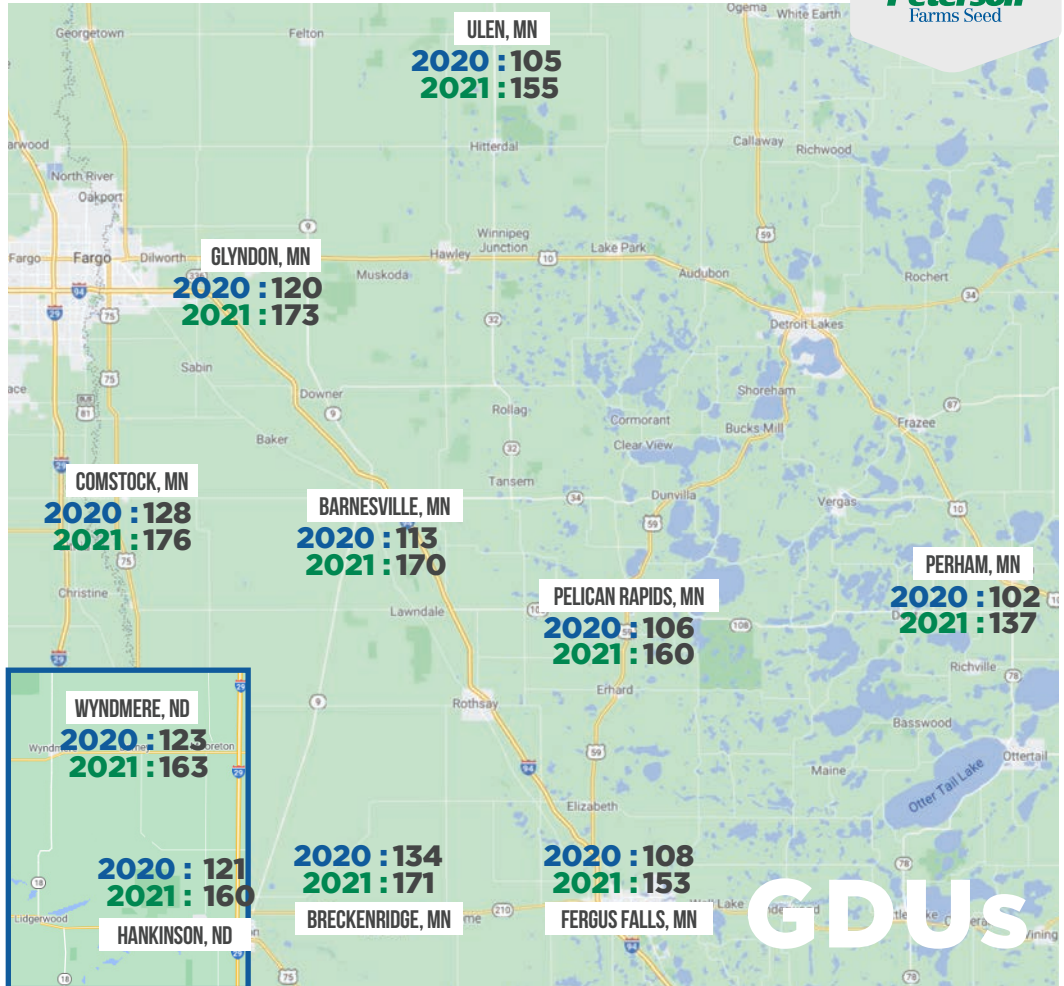

Farmers in my area are 98% done across the board and emergence is coming along well across the region.

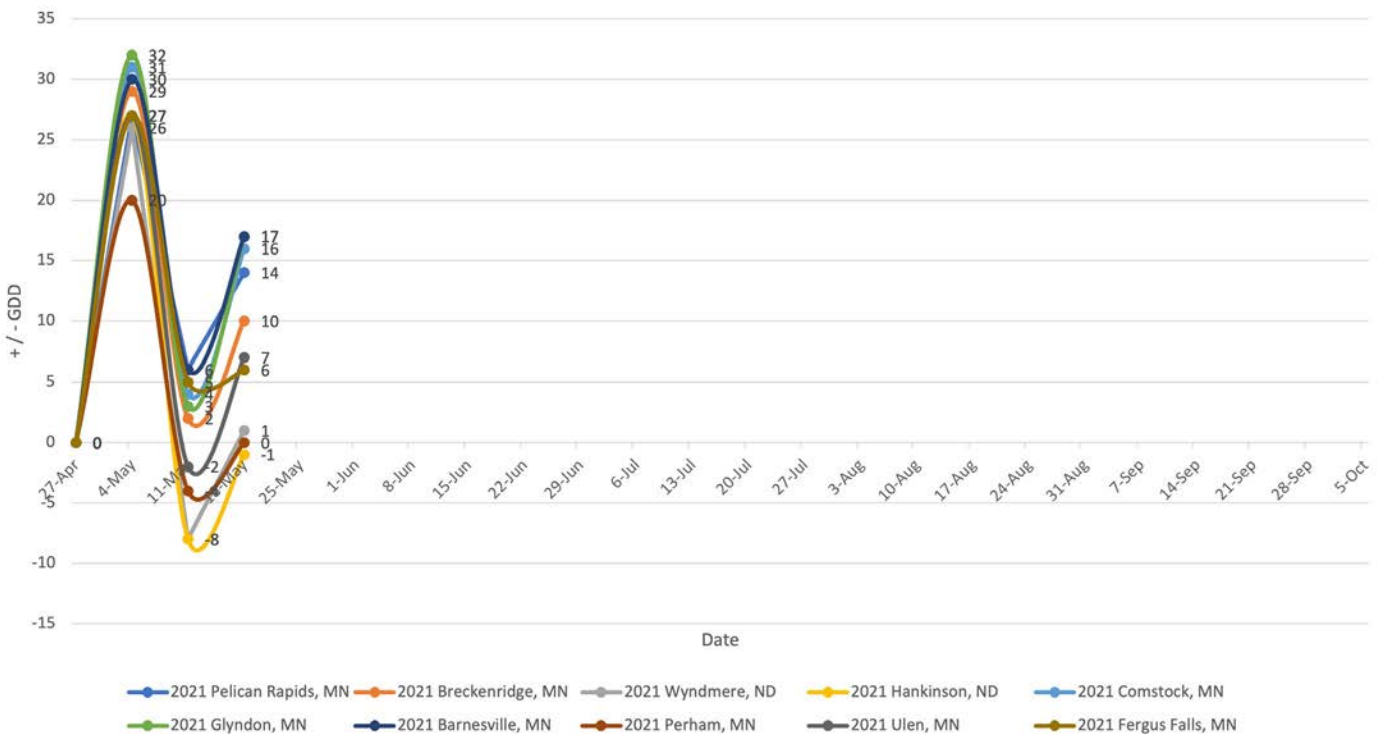
A few areas picked up some rain late last week but, area-wide, we still need more.

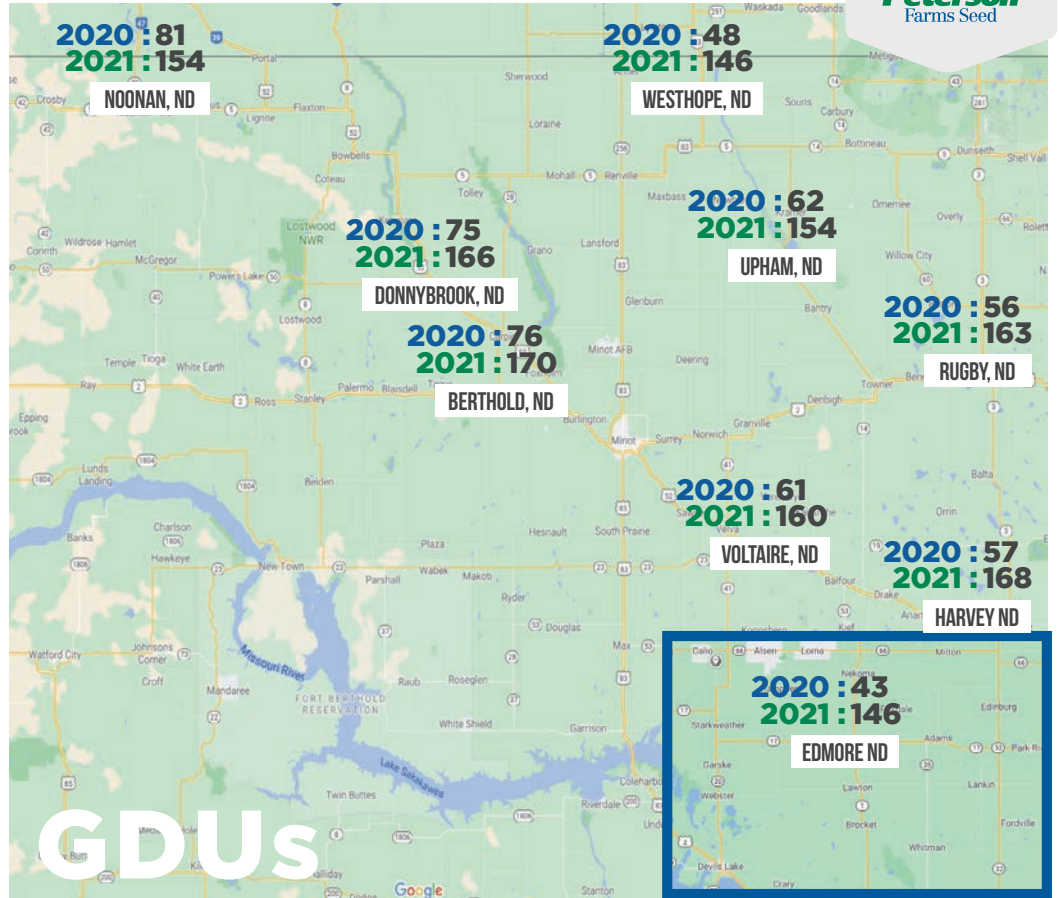
Corn and soybeans are wrapping up up here in NW ND. Some of the early corn and soybeans are starting to emerge with our recent GDU's.

Much needed rain is forecasted the next few days, fingers crossed!



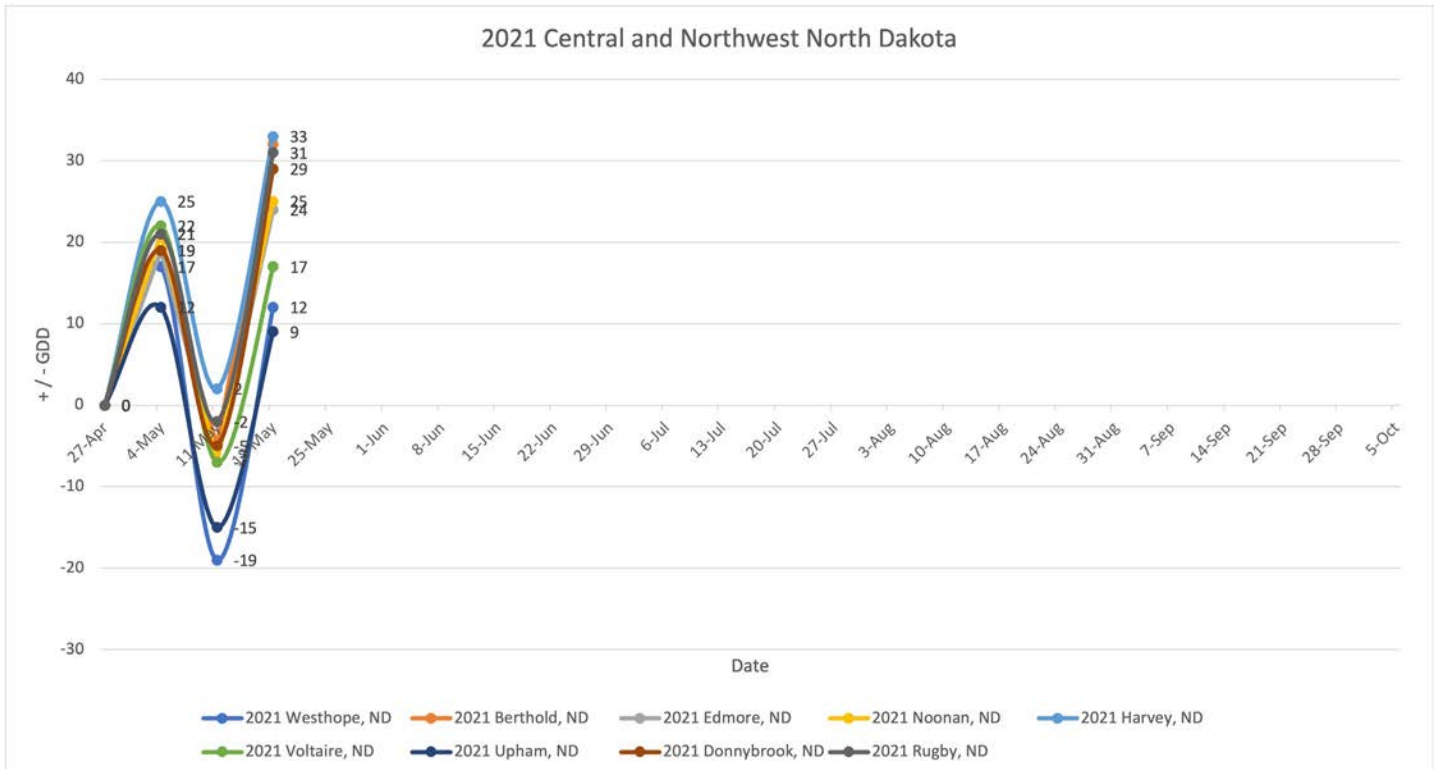

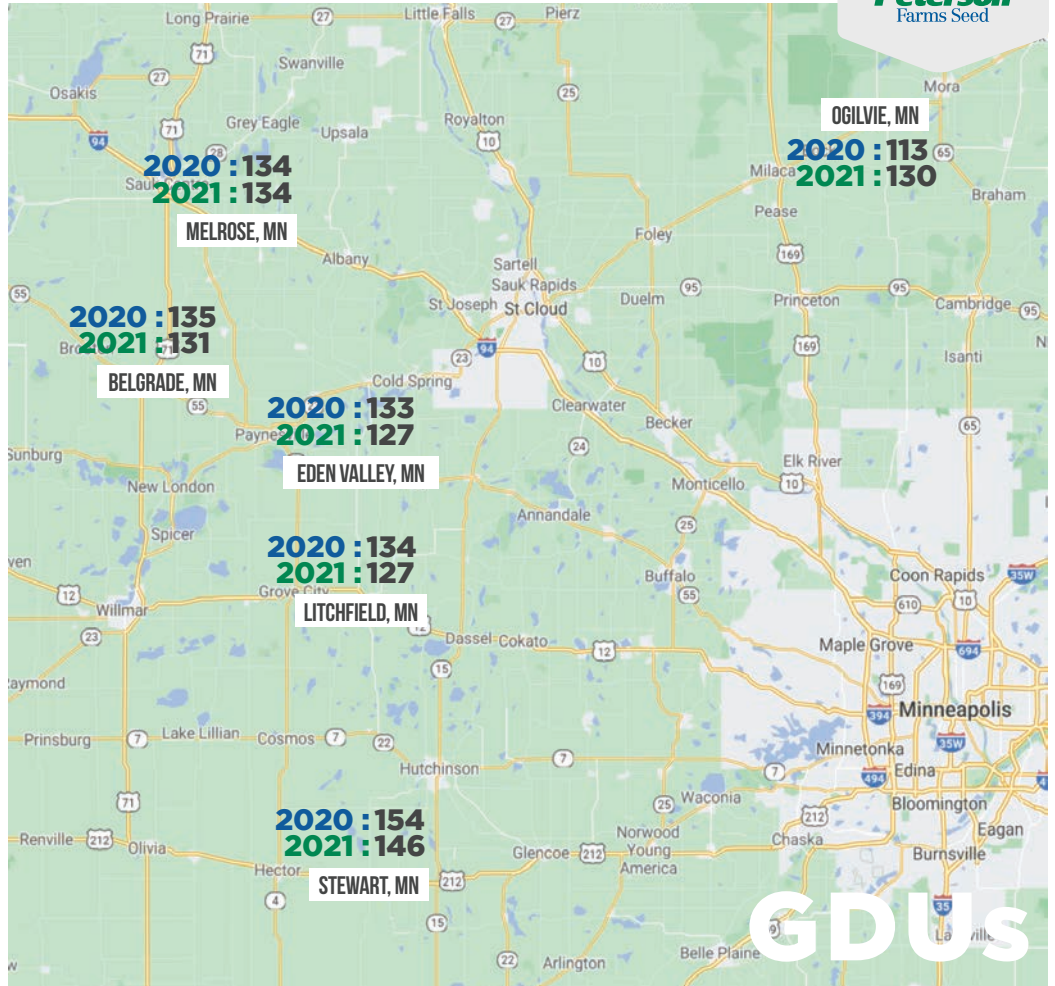

For as dry as it has been, emergence and germ look excellent. Everyone is hoping for rain this week!



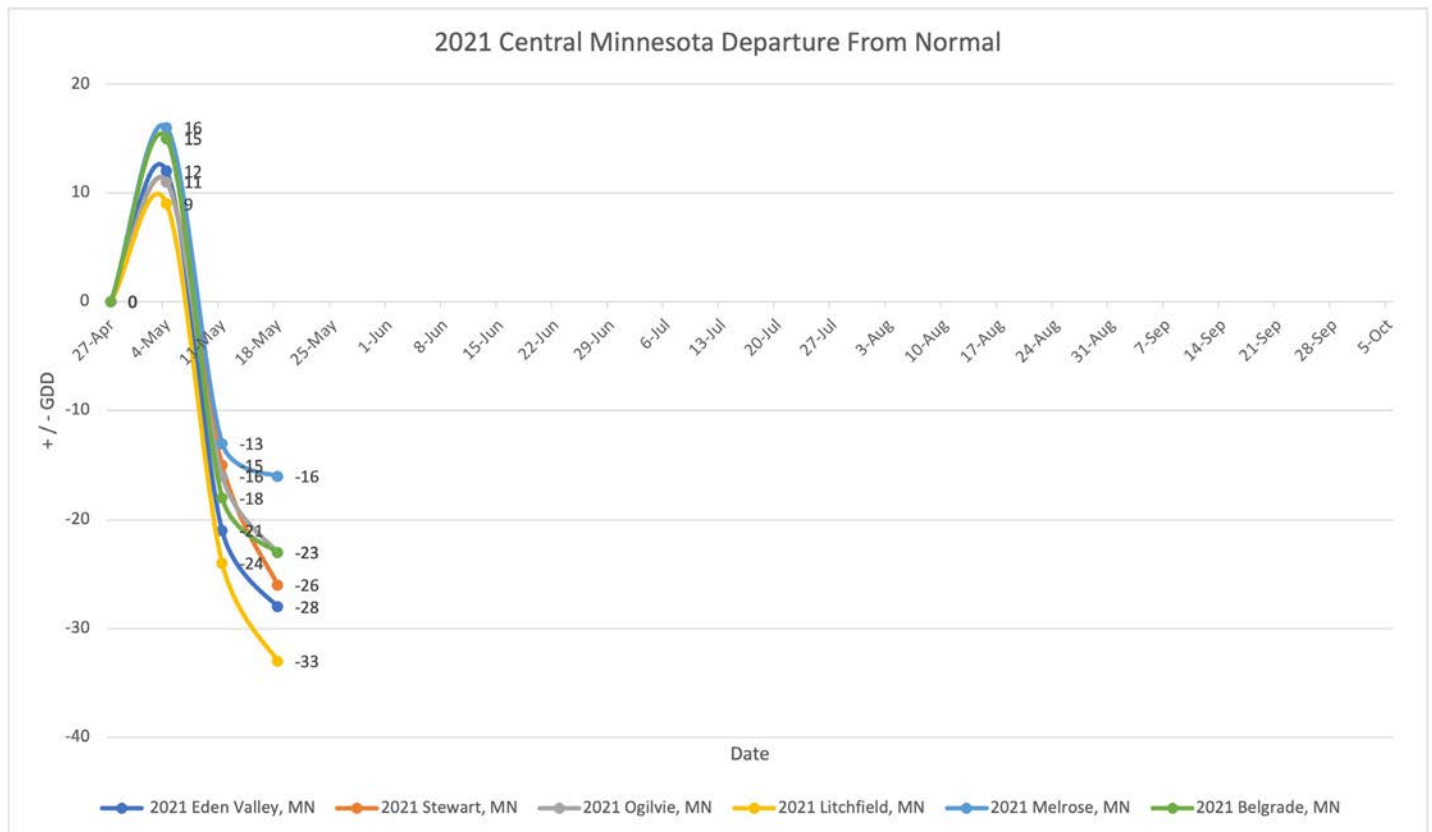
